



## ***Volunteer Mentoring Partnership***

Want to **make** a difference in **a** youth's life? Studies prove that mentoring can make a **difference** in a youth's academics, attendance, and social skills.

We are currently seeking out people who want to make a difference by mentoring a foster child.

- ◆ All mentors will receive initial training and are offered subsequent bi-monthly support group sessions.
- ◆ Mentors are expected to maintain weekly contact with mentees, with in-person visits at least bi-weekly for 2-3 hours.
- ◆ Between visits contact will be sustained through phone calls or email.
- ◆ Group mentoring activities will bring mentor and mentee pairs together for events, such as a trip to local theme parks.
- ◆ Each mentor will receive a monthly stipend of up to \$50 per month for each mentee match.
